

DSP—VEHICLE EMERGENCY PROCEDURE

- 1. Turn on your hazard lights.**
- 2. Pull over to a safe place (if the vehicle is still moving).**
- 3. Turn your wheel to prevent rolling and put on the emergency brake.**
- 4. Triple-check before getting out of the vehicle.**
- 5. Call dispatch for help. If immediate emergency, dial 911.**
- 6. Don appropriate Hi-Viz safety vest.**
- 7. Set up flares or triangles, if you have them.**
(As long as it is safe to do so, put flares or reflective triangles behind your vehicle as follows: one near your vehicle, usually about 10 feet behind it, and the other one farther away.)
- 8. Wait for help in a safe place, with vehicle locked.**

Must Have Items



Flashlight with good batteries



Jack and lug wrench for changing tires



Fire extinguisher



First aid kit



Flares or reflective day/night devices



Spare tire in good condition
